Jane Cantrill is a learning support teacher with over 30 years of experience in a variety of schools and settings. She has extensive training and expertise in Learning Support with children from Kindergarten to Year 6.

For the last 5 years Jane has been specifically working with children within a school setting in literacy and numeracy support programs.

She has trained in the Macquarie University program MiniLit and MacqLit, which provides a sequential series of lessons based on the Science of Reading - phonemic awareness, phonics, visual discrimination, listening skills and fine motor handwriting skills are covered.

Assessments are an integral part of this program to consistently adapt to a student's needs. Hands on activities are also included, to provide a multi-sensory method of learning.

Numeracy support is based on student's individual needs, with strong foundations in place value and the four operations – addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division.

Assessment, guidance, and adaptations are catered towards each individual, with the enjoyment of maths manipulatives, activities and games.

Each session includes explicit instruction through a variety of ways which are designed to make a student feel at ease and successful – this is a number one priority in Jane's lessons. Successful relationships mean successful learning can take place.
